

SICK POLICY

Children should be kept at home, or will be sent home from this school program if they have any of the following symptoms:

- 1) A fever of 100 degrees or more
- 2) A runny nose with a thick green or yellow mucus discharge, vomiting or cough with mucus secretion.
- 3) A cough with mucus secretion (a wheezy cough can spread a bacterial or viral infection on the droplets) when associated with other symptoms, or when persistent.
- 4) Contagious skin ailments such as draining poison oak, impetigo, ringworm, contagious cold sores or fever blisters or lice.
- 5) Recurring diarrhea.
- 6) Vomiting, recurring or with a fever.
- 7) Pink eye or conjunctivitis, if untreated.
- 8) Any untreated/contagious disease (chicken pox, measles, etc.)

Please call if you have any questions about your child's health, or if your child will be absent due to illness so that the other parents can be alerted. Also, consider your contingency plans for caring for your sick child.
